## Zoom Protocols

- Keep your camera on when you are required to be actively involved. Turning your camera off will indicate that you have stepped away or are not present.
- 2. Mute your microphone: unless you are speaking.
- Unmute yourself to ask a question: Then re-mute yourself after asking it.
- 4. **Locate a quiet, indoor location:** as much as possible, please be sure there is no background noise for interactive participation (dogs barking, blenders grinding, kids playing, etc.).
- 5. **Plain background:** if possible please find a plan background when on a call (if possible with no one else in the video and no distractions).
- 6. **Look at the camera** when you are speaking to the group and not the screen.
- 7. Always remember that everyone can see you when you have your camera on: large movements or doing other activities could be distracting to others.
- 8. **No pyjamas:** please dress for your online participation the same way you would for an in-person course.
- 9. **Be aware of the light source:** sitting with your back to a window or bright light will silhouette your face. Try to ensure the light course is behind camera directed at you for us to best see you.
